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Registration Tips

In order to qualify for the Spring registration discount all participants have to be registered in the myscouts system by June 30, 2015. The grace period for the group to process the actual paperwork is extended until July 10 i.e. the package with payment should be in the council office either before July 10 or the package must bear post office stamp with July 10 date.

Youth having more than one role (participant)

Kim, Keeo, Venturer/Rover in more than one Group

Groups are not able to properly add a second participant role in myscouts. Adding a second role to currently active participant by re-registering him/her (whether in the same or other group) creates another invoice. The invoice has to be manually voided at the council level. Please contact Council Registrar, Ladka Stodola at lstodola@scouts.ca to have a second participant role added to a youth.

Since Kim and Keeo roles are listed only under volunteer roles but are part of the participants' program, they have to be added to presently active participants by council registrars. Please note that no mandatory requirements apply for Kims and Keeos roles i.e. no requirements will appear under 'Requires' column. Also, the 30-60-90 policy does not apply to them. Membership in 2 different Groups (participant or adult)

Because of the cross-group membership, Council Registrar Ladka is the only person who should be doing this. A Group cannot add a role to a member if they belong to a different group. They should email Ladka with the request so the role can be added and the group commissioner from the other group is informed so the screening of that volunteer can be done on their level.

Transfers (participant or adult)

If the GC of the second group adds the member it creates a second profile and that causes problems in myscouts member database. If a second profile is created it would require a merge in order to keep all scouting information about the member in one profile. As well, it can cause login problems for the member in myscouts.



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First year scouters pending (adult)

Currently the full Woodbadge (MS1) is not included in the 30-60-90 policy so if that is the only thing missing they will not be inactivated as a result of not having the MS1.

If a first year Scouter is missing MS1 at the end of August 31, 2015 they will still remain active as of September 1, 2015. But if they are returning to the same section then they have to complete MS1 within 90 day with accordance to 30-60-90 policy otherwise they will be inactivated.

PRC expired within scouting year

If Scouters were registered before their PRC expired the grace period till August 31, 2015 is granted to them to renew their PRC and they will remain active.

But if Scouters did not renew their PRC they will become inactive as of September 1, 2015. The 30-60-90 policy does not apply in this case.
