Getting your Letter to Camp

To ensure mail delivery to camp, please use the following address only. Do not use Priority Post:

We suggest you write a note to your camper and mail it before she/he actually leaves for camp. Or, deliver your note in a sealed envelope to one of our staff at check-in on the day of departure.

Mail is distributed by your camper's counsellors at various points throughout the week. Timing is based on the camper's comfort level and the program activity level. Mail is not delivered daily.

There is no E-mail address for camp.

The Do's and Don't's of Sending a Letter

We urge parents to use discretion when writing their children, especially first time campers. In our experience, certain messages from home can trigger and/or fuel homesickness. Follow our tips to help alleviate any negative feelings your camper may be having!

Do: be Positive and Excited! Phrases such as "We hope you are having a great time!" and "What is your favourite activity so far?" help to focus your camper on the great time they are having at camp, not what they are missing at home.

Don't: talk about things you will be doing while he/she is away or when he/she gets back. Talking about a vacation or a family event that you will be doing may make them wish they were at home and trigger sadness at camp.

Don't: give him/her bad news in a letter.
